**Celebrant:** Dear brothers and sisters, we fret and toil but do not find solutions to our problems because we go about without seeking the assistance of the Wisdom which God has placed at our disposal. Let us pray for an increase of the Wisdom of God as we place our petitions before Him, we pray...

**Response:** Lord, hear our prayer.
