Celebrant: Jesus suffered and died for all and rose again. This way he gained victory over death once and for all. Response: Lord, hear our prayer.

3. For all the souls in purgatory, that God may look on their faith and pardon them the punishment that their sins deserve and bring them into the light of his kingdom, **we pray to the Lord.**
4. For all the those who have lost their loved ones, that they may be consoled in their grief and be assured that God is present with those who mourn, **we pray to the Lord.**
5. Let us pray for our personal needs, , **we pray to the Lord.**

Concluding prayer (Celebrant): God, our loving Father, we thank you for the gift of your Son Jesus, who gave up his life for us so that we may enjoy eternal life. Grant that through the understanding of this great mystery we may never experience sorrow or sadness but rather be joyful in the hope of our salvation, we make this prayer, through Christ our Lord, Amen.
